CONFIDENTIAL COURT SETTLEMENT ADVERSE COURT JUDGEMENT RUSSIA

RPMGlobal Holdings Limited (ASX: RUL) (the **Company**) hereby advises that its wholly owned Russian subsidiary has now entered into a full and final settlement agreement relating to the adverse court judgement in Russia first announced by the Company on 21 July 2016.

The terms of the settlement, which were signed by both parties to the dispute and thereafter sealed and approved by the Moscow Arbitrazh court are confidential, however the Company confirms it has obtained a full and final settlement and release of all obligations and liabilities arising both out of the adverse judgement and relating to the original project and contract to which the judgement relates.

The Company does not expect this confidential settlement to result in any additional expenses in its Consolidated Statement of Financial Position for financial year 2019. Discussions continue with RPM's insurers who have confirmed policy coverage for this claim subject to the policy terms and conditions.

This dispute which has been conducted under Russian law has been an illuminating experience for all involved.

This matter is now concluded.
